

How to...: Direct Claim (IGC-File)

General:

Direct Claim (IGC-File) is the most simple and safest way of flight claiming. This very comfortable process was first introduced with OLC2.0 and by now has established itself with most pilots.

How does it work?

1. Login

After entering your login into your personal competitor details, you can log in to OLC2.0 and use a number of exclusive functions.





Details about logging in can be found in How to... "Login".

2. Access Direct claim via menu

First, click on "Gliding" or "ParaHangliding", depending on which competition the flight shall be claimed in.



Next, in menu "Claim Flight", click on "Direct Claim (IGC-File)".

3. Select competitor and upload IGC-File



Should you be registered as "Trusted Competitor" in the accounts of other competitors, you can use the little arrow next to the pilot identification to select a different name (details see How to... "Trusted Competitor")

4. Enter some details:


Additional details can be added or altered here. It is also possible to enter more accurate "flight without propulsions" times.



Please do not forget to click on "reload" next to the barogram after altering times of "flight without propulsion".

5. Confirmation page

That's all there is to it. The following page confirms the successful flight claim. The flight will be listed in the adequate rankings quickly but depending on server load.
